

2012 Finals Ground Rules

- All contestants must wear back numbers while competing in arena NO EXCEPTIONS Failure to wear back number will result in \$25 fine
- All timed event contestants in the performance MUST ride in the Grand Entry. Incentive event contestants are encouraged to ride in the Grand Entry
- All Rough Stock must be "chapped up" for introductions during opening ceremonies each performance
- The winner in each event during the performance is required to take a victory lap. A horse will be provided for Rough Stock contestants
- Order of competition at the finals: All events excluding Barrels will be 1st day 15-1, 2nd day slowest to fastest/low score to high score. Barrels - 1st day in drawn order, 2nd day reverse order of 1st day, will rake after every 5 in Barrels.
- Inc. Calf Roping 2 loops are allowed if 2 loops are carried. Open Calf Roping and Breakaway 1 loop only.
- #12 Team Roping 3 loops allowed no swapping ends. Open Team Roping - 2 loops only
- Rough Stock contestants must be over their drawn stock when previous contestant leaves the chute
- GCPRA dress code rule will be strictly enforced-this means collared long sleeved shirts (no pullovers) per rule book
- All contestants must be ready to compete when called

Rodeo Grounds Information

- Arena will be closed 2 hours prior to start of each performance
- A warm up arena will be available all weekend for all contestants
- All horses must be stalled. No tie ups, no portable pens, no exceptions
- St. Lukes/GCPRA Sports Medicine Team onsite all weekend
- Very limited trailer plug in's
