- All Team Roping will run Friday, September 13th at 8am following Barrel Racing slack
- **ABSOLUTELY NO ONE** in the arena at any time unless competing and we mean ANYTIME!
- All Ropers must exit from the bottom of the arena
- Barrel Racers- they will rake after 5.... There will be only 10 in a perf
- Buckles will be awarded to each event champion. Vests will be awarded to the winner of each event in each performance
- There will be a Warm-Up Arena available at all times, including slack
- There will be a Farrier on the grounds at all times
- There will be a Veterinarian on the ground at all times
- There will be a VIP area for contestants and personnel

Arena Rules:

1. This Rodeo will have a closed arena. All contestants enter from behind the box. The only exception is if it is a safety issue and the judge(s) makes the call.
2. No one enters the arena unless the Arena Director or a judge say to do so. It is a safety concern. The rule also goes for in front of the bucking chutes... If you don't have an official shirt on, you need not be there.
3. The 3 call rule will be enforced
