Here are a few things to think about the next time you go to a Rodeo:

- 1. **Be kind.** Most of the people we encounter at the rodeos are volunteers or fans. So be nice they are not the ones making the rules they are just trying to do a good job.
- 2. **Nothing is FREE.** Committees have to make money. The idea that just because we are contestants everything is free is wrong. No one is trying to rob you. They just need to cover their cost so they can do it again next year.
- 3. **Pick up After Yourself.** We are all adults, clean up your own mess. If you wouldn't do it at your place don't do it at theirs.
- 4. Respect the Rules. Most of our committees have Liquor Licenses to sell alcohol at the events. That means we cannot bring outside liquor in. This puts the committees at jeopardy of losing their license and getting monetarily fined. Please support them by leaving your alcohol at home and buying it from them. They want you to have fun and enjoy your time, but they have to follow the law or it could cost them <u>and</u> us a rodeo.

- 5. **Thank your Sponsors.** The GCPRA board of directors works very hard to get and keep sponsors for our association. Please take the time to thank them; and, when possible, shop with them. They are doing a lot to give back..... We need to support them.
